Linda Hahn is a NQA Certified teacher who has written numerous books and articles. She even has a fabric collection that should have arrived in stores in 2020! Linda's classes are fun and empowering! Linda has a way of taking a project that looks complex and breaking it down in such a way that's easy to understand. She is a high energy—low stress teacher.

FEELIN CRABBY? Is a full day class for confident beginners and beyond. The class features Linda's method of creating the New York Beauty block using only ONE pin! The project does not require any previous foundation piecing experience. There is a kit fee (payable to the teacher) of \$28.00 that includes the foundation paper (which can be left in the quilt), custom acrylic templates, re-useable foundation piecing stencil and full color pattern.
