Coming in September — We have a really outstanding program coming up this month. Kathy McNeil, an internationally award-winning quilt artist, teacher and judge will be joining us from Marysville, Washington. She hand-appliques thousands of little scraps of fabric together, creating quilts that look like paintings. Often using over a hundred different fabrics in one composition, she revels in adding small details and surprises for the viewer to find. The quilting itself adds an additional element of texture to her work. Her quilts are frequently featured in museums, magazines, calendars and international shows. Many of her quilts are in private collections.

Kathy's lecture will be "A Playground of Mixed Techniques in Pictorial Quilts." You won't believe the level of detail in her quilts and you won't want to miss this meeting! Come, take notes and feast your eyes on Kathy's outstanding works of art!

On Tuesday, Sept. 16, Kathy will be teaching her Animal Boutique class. Sorry, this class is full.

PHD (Projects Half Done) Challenge Ends -

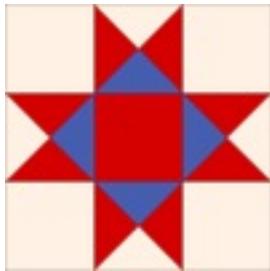

New Challenge Starting — Jerre Reese and DJ Stultz have come up with a new challenge starting this month but don't worry, it's not due until our December meeting. You have plenty of time to complete it. This challenge is called "design your own block." Maybe it should be called "design your own variation of a block." But you get the idea!!

The block is a very familiar design - The Ohio Star.



The challenge is to create your own variation of this block. Everyone will do the same size block - 12 1/2" unfinished. The colors and the variation of the design are totally up to you. Jerre and DJ will explain more about the challenge. A larger copy of the block is at the end of this newsletter.

Coming in October — Judy Lilly, one of CCQ's most accomplished quilters, will be doing a lecture and trunk show. 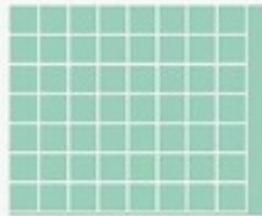

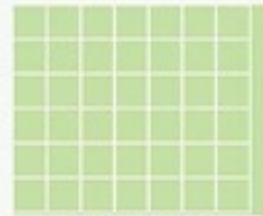

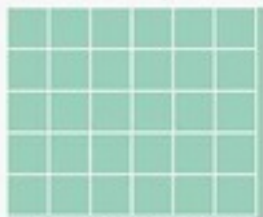
99 - 2" Squares



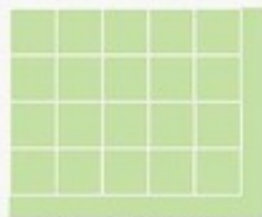
56 - 2.5" Squares



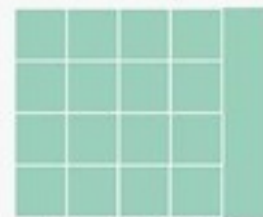
42 - 3" Squares



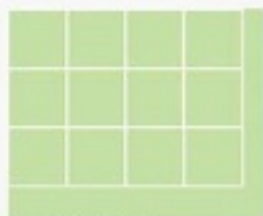
30 - 3.5" Squares



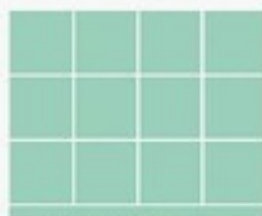
20 - 4" Squares



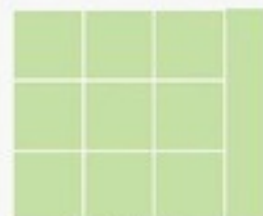

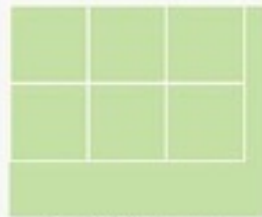

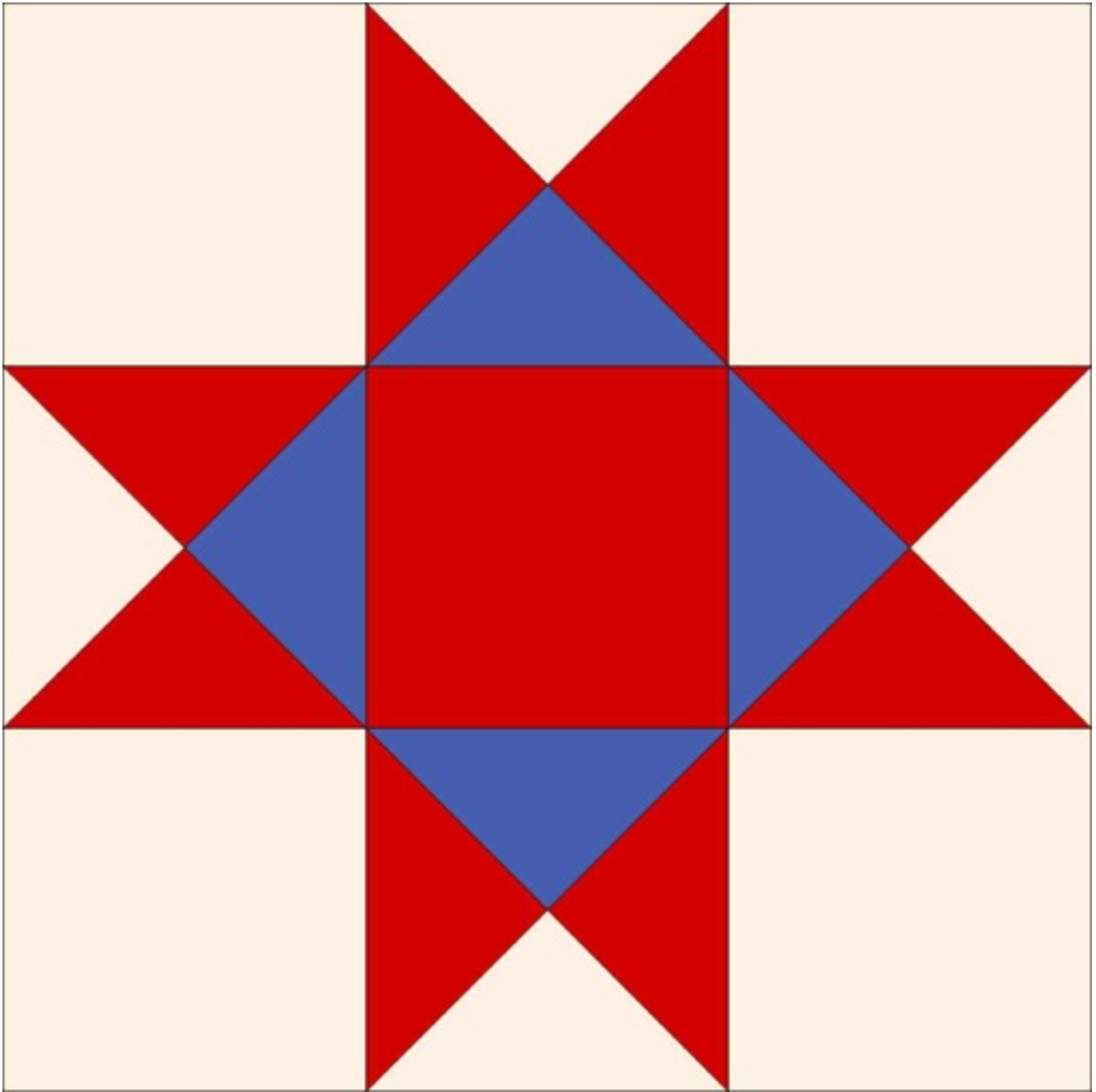
