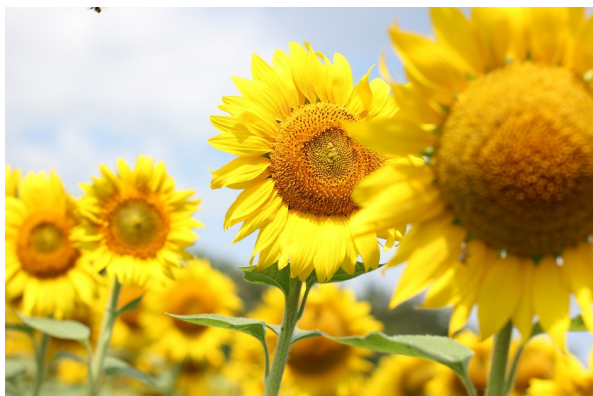

If you were unable to attend **Meet the Quilter** you missed a great presentation by Cheryl Brickey. Cheryl showed samples of all the quilts in her latest book called “Just One Charm Pack Quilts”. Some of her patterns are fast and easy and all patterns done with 5” squares. The light bulb came on for Pam and me! Although CCQ doesn’t have charm packs, we do have oodles and oodles of 5” squares. Cheryl has given us permission to use her patterns for our charity projects. One pattern is called Charming Stripes and we plan to kit up. If you got the book, check it out. It is very versatile; it could easily be made larger for an older child. Stay tuned...more to come about that.

One last thing. If one of your goals this year is to trim down your stash, please consider making a child’s top or two and donating it. We are in desperate need of older boy’s tops no larger than 55”x 65”. We have backing and batting. Or if you have scraps, we can use those too. 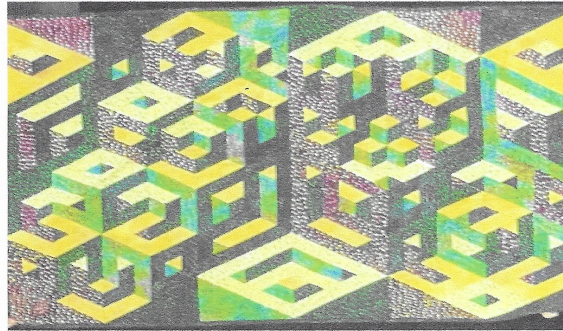
## CCQ can always use fabrics for charity projects:

- \* **Bead bags** – cut 2 – 9”x 12” rectangles of a child’s focus fabric
- \* **Pillowcases**—cut 9” x WOF (OR 8 ½” to 8 ¾” will work) for a cuff and 27” x WOF for the body
- \* **Kits**—cut 5”

3-D Tumbling Blocks

With Phil Gold

Phil Gold was a software designer for almost 50 years and uses his engineering skills to design interesting and creative quilt blocks. During this class you will have time to make 3 different blocks that may be assembled into a table runner. A 4<sup>th</sup> block would make a small art quilt. To achieve the 3-D effect, you will learn to work with light, medium and dark values. Unlike many hexagon quilts, Phil's method doesn't involve ANY "Y" seams. You will be impressed with how easy it is to put these blocks together.
