Tuesday, February 21st - Tina Roth will teach her Mandala class. Look over your supply list again to be sure you have everything you need. Doors will open at 8:30 and class will start promptly at 9:00. Please don't be late!! Come have some fun and don't forget to bring your lunch and something to drink.

Missouri Star Demo - Sandy Jacobs will demo the Disappearing 9-Patch. This is a quick and fun pattern. Both beginning and experienced quilters love to make this one. If you've made a Disappearing 9-Patch quilt, bring it to show. It's always fun to see how different the quilts look using different fabrics.

Color Wheel Challenge Rules - The project is a table runner. Choose a main color for your project. Look at a color wheel to find the opposite color to your main color; this will be your secondary color. Don't be afraid to use shades or tints of your colors. For example, instead of green and red, you might use mint and pink; or consider peach and baby blue, lemon and lavender or magenta and lime. Be creative. There are hundreds of color combinations possible!! You can make your table runner any size you wish and use any technique like pieced, appliqué, whole cloth or a combination of techniques. Lastly, you may also add a small amount of black, white or grey. This challenge ends in June and prizes will be awarded.
