Love Links or Star Shadows Workshop Application

Wing Clipper and Magic Wand workshop. One of the most used units in any project is the Flying Geese unit. Since this is a Studio 180 Design tool, units are made oversized and then trimmed down for accurately pieced units.

Love Links - interlocking chevrons make a fun and unique looking quilt. A difficult looking design that is made easy using flying geese, making this a quick and easy quilt to master.

Star Shadows – Create the illusion of stars floating over the surface and casting shadows below. Fabric color choices of light/medium/dark help create the shadows for this quilt.

One-day workshop; skill level: skilled beginner or above

Date: Tuesday, June 22, 2021
