4" Finished Block

Fabric Requirements

Sky Blue



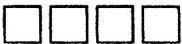
four 1-1/2" by 2-1/2" rectangles of Fabric A

Sand Beige



four 1-1/2" squares of Fabric B

Dark Ocean Blue



four 1-1/2" squares of the background Fabric C

White



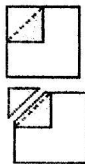
one 2-1/2" square of the White



Piecing the Block



1) Lightly mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 1-1/2" fabric B squares as shown.



2) Place the 1-1/2" fabric B square on the 2-1/2" white center as shown, right sides together. Sew on the diagonal line that is marked on the 1-1/2" fabric B square. Trim fabric 1/4" from the sewn diagonal line is optional. Press seam toward fabric B.



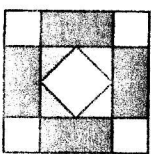
3) Repeat step 2 on the other 3 corners. This completes the center square in a square block unit. This unit should measure 2-1/2" square.



4) Piece two of the 1-1/2" squares of fabric C with one of the 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles of fabric A as shown. Press the seam allowances toward the fabric A rectangle. Repeat with the remaining two 1-1/2" fabric C squares and one of the remaining 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" fabric A rectangles. This completes the top and bottom row of the quilt block. The finished rows should measure 4-1/2" x 2-1/2".



5) Sew a 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" fabric A rectangles to two sides of the square in a square unit, piece the center row of the block as shown. Press the seams toward the fabric A rectangles. The completed row should measure 4-1/2" x 2-1/2".



6) Sew the three rows together as shown to complete the block. Press the seams away from the center row. The finished block should measure 4-1/2" square which includes a 1/4" seam allowance on all sides.

7) Finish as desired. Write or print your name on your name tag.
