01/17	<b>Round Tables</b> –Curved piecing, Y seams/Partial seams, Borders with a diagonal strip and Mitered borders
02/21	<b>Linda Hahn</b> – Linda is best known for her unique technique for creating New York Beauty blocks using just ONE PIN and the blocks come out perfect the first attempt! She is also the author of multiple award winning books. Her patterns have been published in many quilt magazines as well. <b>Spring Challenge Begins</b>
02/22	<b>Linda Hahn – Feeling Crabby</b> - Have some fun learning Linda’s ONE PIN technique for making New York Beauty Blocks!! Then...take those blocks and create a pieced background for a beach scene!! This can be kicked up by attaching some shells, fish, etc. You will also learn how to create an (optional) miniature quilt using the scraps and cutaways from the main project. <b>This is a WORKSHOP exclusive!</b> The pattern is only provided to workshop students!
03/10	<b>Meet The Quilters</b> - Cheryl Brickey – Meadow Mist Designs – In addition to being a busy wife and mother to two, Cheryl is a chemical engineer by day and a quilter by night. Cheryl’s trunk show shares her story of how she became a quilter and how her work has evolved over time by sharing her first quilt and many quilts throughout her journey.
03/11	<b>Class by Cheryl Brickey</b> – Spinning Stars – Make a geometric, paper pieced pattern with a secondary star pattern that emerges as the quilt top is assembled. The pattern includes instructions for two sizes: baby and lap.
