

### **Baby Quilt Tops Needed:**

It may seem a little early, but we are thinking ahead to the summer workshops. We typically have about 50 baby quilt tops ready for the summer. We are far short of that number now. Pam worked really hard preparing the baby kits and we have lots!! All we need is for you to take one or more kits home, make the top and return it by our April 18<sup>th</sup> meeting. That's it!! Most of the layering, sewing and quilting is done in the summer workshops. As an incentive, you will get a fat quarter, of your own choosing, for every completed quilt top you turn in. The patterns we use are very simple and they take very little time to complete. For example, the Big Block pattern, takes about 15 minutes to make. Most all the patterns we use are on the website. ## Spinning Stars Workshop Application

Instructor: Cheryl Brickey



Spinning Stars is a geometric, paper pieced pattern with a secondary star pattern that emerges as the quilt top is assembled. This quilt is an advanced beginner to intermediate level pattern and assumes basic paper piecing skills. The pattern includes instructions for two sizes: baby  $46\frac{1}{2} \times 56$  and lap  $56\frac{1}{2} \times 70\frac{1}{2}$

One-day workshop; skill level: skilled beginner or above

**Date:** Friday, March 11, 2022

**Time:** 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.

**Place:** General Robert H. Reed Rec Center – back room

**Cost:** \$40 - Payment is due at time of sign up. Supply list will be sent once you have signed up and paid.

**Reservation Deadline:** No later than February 21, 2022. Class will be opened to other guilds February 22nd.



3-D Tumbling Blocks

With Phil Gold

Phil Gold was a software designer for almost 50 years and uses his engineering skills to design interesting and creative quilt blocks. During this class you will have time to make 3 different blocks that may be assembled into a table runner. A 4<sup>th</sup> block would make a small art quilt. To achieve the 3-D effect, you will learn to work with light, medium and dark values. Unlike many hexagon quilts, Phil’s method doesn’t involve ANY “Y” seams. You will be impressed with how easy it is to put these blocks together.
