## **Charity News**

**Charm quilts** early. They were awesome. But now time is up. Please bring your finished Charm quilts to OSV on June 16th. If you have any questions, please contact me at cdwool31@frontier.com or call/text 843-655-4826.

#### Tips on finishing the quilt:

Layer and turn the quilt: We did not supply binding, we intended for the quilts to be layered, sewn around and turned as we do the quilts in the summer workshops. At the opening to turn the quilt, be sure to sew the backing to the batting about an 1/8" in. This makes it easier to turn the quilt and keeps the batting from shifting.

<u>The label:</u> Please do not hand sew the label. Machine sew completely around the label using a straight stitch.

Quilting the quilt: Before quilting, first pin sufficiently to keep all the layer from shifting. Keep the quilting simple! Except for around the border, in the ditch quilting does not work well for this quilt. I suggest using a decorative stitch, like a serpentine or stretch-stitch along all the diagonal seams.

<u>July 21st Workshop Sign-up Sheets Available</u>: Last month we had a few people sign up to help at the July 21st workshop, but we still need lots more sewers and worker bees. Please help if you can.

#### Here's the to-do list:

- 80 baby tops with backs and batting ready to sew around, turn, press and quilt.
- 30 quilt backs to press.
- 30 bindings to make. Strips are cut but need to be joined/sewn and pressed.

#### The panel challenges rules are as follows:

- 1. Pick a panel, any panel. You can use a panel of your own if you'd like.
- 2. Get creative! Don't just slap borders on the panel. This IS a challenge!
- 3. The finished size of the quilt should correspond to the age of the child. See the chart on our website for the recommended sizes.
- 4. Entry must be totally complete, which means quilted, bound and labeled.
- 5. Prizes awarded: There's no voting. Your name will go in a basket. Names will be drawn for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places prizes.
- 6. All completed challenges are due at the Sept 15th meeting.

## Sunny Dream Oval Table Runner: "Stained Glass" Technique



#### Required Materials


- 6-8 fat quarters (quantity depends on how many different fabrics/colors you use in the layout. There are 7 different fabrics in the sample)
- 35 x 50 rectangle of plain fabric (such as muslin.) This fabric is used as a base to adhere the quilt top pieces)
- 6 yds of Wonder Under
- · Bias tape -options:
  - o Clover fusible Bias Tape 1 roll 1/4" width
  - o 1/4" double fold bias tape 3 packages (select color of choice)
  - Make your own ¼" bias tape (10 yards)
- Fabric glue/glue stick
- Several pencils
- Scissors for cutting paper and fabric
- Thread to match your bias tape
- Iron and mat
- Sewing machine
- Double needle (this is optional)

- General sewing supplies: Scissors, seam ripper, etc

- Tape that is visible and can easily be removed from the ruler, such as Post-it tape, painters tape, masking tape

## Square in a Square System Designed by Jodi Barrows Taught by Gloria Stickney, Sew Fabulous, Inc. Winston-Salem, NC

Join us for a 3 hour class utilizing the Square in a Square ruler designed by Jodi Barrows. Learn to make star points without having to cut and sew triangles. Just start with a square and sew strips on all 4 sides then trim with your ruler. It's like MAGIC!!

Join us **DATE** for an introduction class to the Square in a Square (SNS) System. Start with a square in the middle and sew strips on all four sides. Create a simple **Square inside a Square** with four easy trims (Option 1). Or use the same process to create perfect **flying geese** (option 3) and **half square triangles** (Option 4). You can create 50 different options with one ruler or a countless number of designs when combining options. One ruler and nearly 50 options and the combination of options is unlimited!

**During class we will create a Patriotic Block** using this amazing SNS System to create a basic Option 1 square inside a square and

an Option 3 Flying Geese to create perfect star points. I will show you tricks and tips for using the SNS system and create units in ANY SIZE. I will demonstrate how to use color as a mechanism to create an optical illusion when joining square units. I will teach how to read the lines of the SNS ruler to create units that will precisely match points to align with our human elements of sewing.

As time allows, I will introduce advanced elements of the SNS System. How do you create a Flying Goose inside a Flying Goose (Option 15)? Step up the process and start with a diamond to create Canadian Geese (Option 18) with long narrow points. Observe the Option 17 to create the Bouquet Block. Did you know you can use SNS System to create the Storm at Sea? No template cutting needed. You can also create Mariner's Compass style blocks without paper-piecing. Just start with a diamond. The list goes on and on. One ruler with nearly 50 Options and the combination of options is unlimited in ANY SIZE.

With the charts of the Square in a Square System, the math has been calculated to easily combine options creating new designs. This is my "GO TO" system for all design work. The math has already been done!

#### Supplies needed:

\$8.95 Class Kit/\$39.95 Square in a Square Ruler designed by Jodi Barrows – purchase at Sew Fabulous

\$30.00 Class Fee Rotary Cutter & mat

Basic Sewing supplies (scissors, pins, white thread, seam ripper, etc)

Iron / ironing mat Sewing machine

**Note:** The SNS Ruler/Book combo: The 9" x 12" ruler is packaged with Quick & Easy Quilts pattern book which contains 5 options, 21 blocks and 6 patterns. We will also PRECUT the pieces of the patriotic block and have it ready for you to sew

during class. This makes for a valuable class time to learn about the amazing Square in a Square System.
