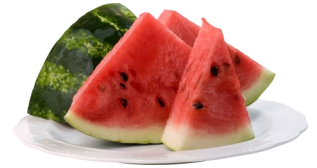

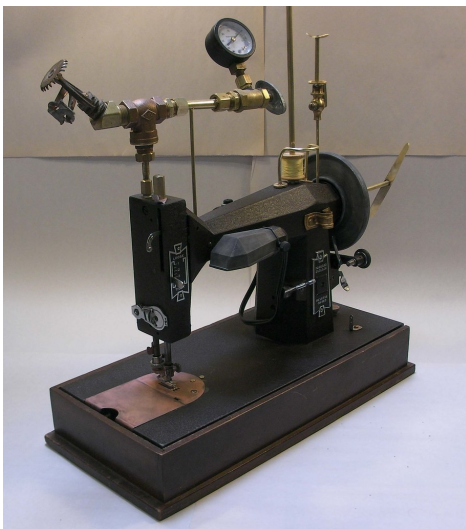

Interested in making your own Best Press? Pam Hays found this recipe online and shares it with us!

## INGREDIENTS

3 cups distilled water (it must be distilled because some tap waters can stain your fabric)

1/2 cup vodka. Use only vodka because it has no real odor. (\*vodka is made from fermented potatoes which are a natural starch)

1/4 to 1/2 tsp. bergamot essential oil or any citrus essential oil

\*UPDATE: After more research, I found that most vodkas are NOT made from potatoes. Most are made from cereal grains. I use Smirnoff which is made from corn. Conclusion, just use the cheapest unflavored vodka you can find.

Combine the essential oil and vodka then add all ingredients to a 1 L/1 qt. container with a lid. Replace the lid of the container and shake the solution well. Pour into a spray bottle. Shake well before each use.
