	<ul> <li>6 panels (or 7 if you want the panel to be in the center of your quilt)</li> <li>60 degree triangle ruler (mine is Creative Grids)</li> <li>24" ruler, at least 4" wide</li> <li>Cutting mat and rotary cutter (with a new blade)</li> <li>Flower pins</li> <li>Forked pins. Optional, but very helpful once you start putting the top together</li> <li>Sewing machine that you know how to operate and the manual</li> <li>Basic sewing supplies</li> <li>Design wall / flannel-backed tablecloth</li> <li>Border fabric and backing (I like to get these after the top is done.
