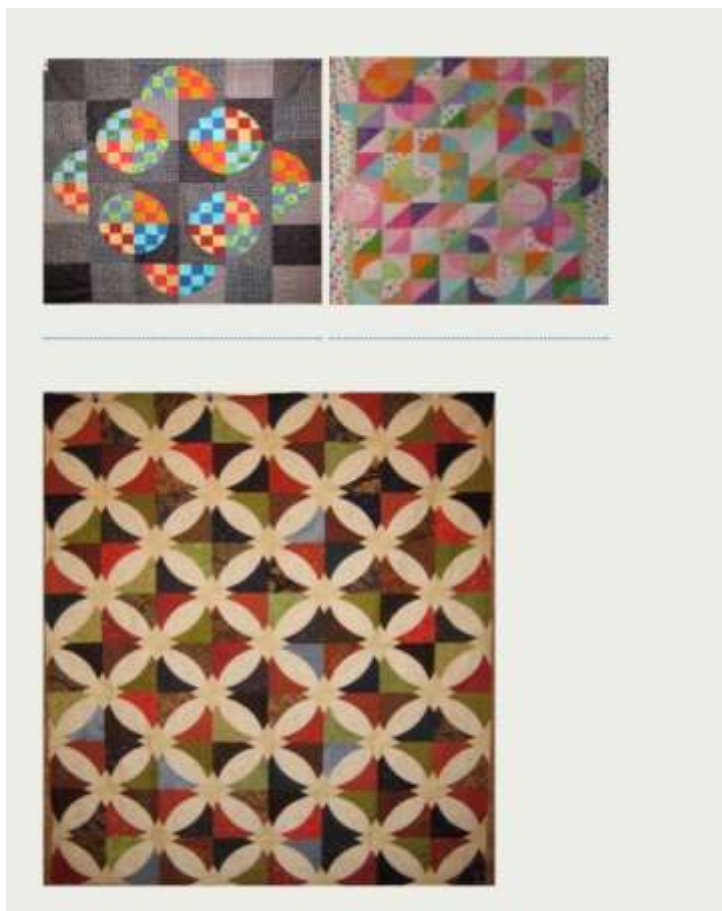

CCQ July 15th Workshop

We hope that those of you that signed up for the July workshop are looking forward to a productive day working for our charitable organizations. We at CCQ get to do the fun job of making and donating the quilts, bead bags and pillowcases to Family Outreach of Horry County, Fostering Hope and MUSC Children's Hospital. These organizations provide such an important service to these children and we are happy to play a small part in supporting them. Remember, our name goes on every quilt so we need everyone to do their best possible work. If you have a problem, please don't continue, stop and ask for help.

Thank you in advance for all your help!

The doors will open at 8:30, sewers please be set up and ready to go at 9 a.m.

Sewers of baby quilts: please bring the following...

- Sewing machine with a walking foot and decorative stitches, if possible. Also, it is extremely helpful if you can adjust the downward pressure of your presser foot especially when sewing the flannel quilts. Please check your manual if you're not aware of this feature.
- Extension table for your machine is very helpful
- Extension cord and/or multiplug
- Spare machine needles (in case you break one)
- Quilting glove: it's helpful, if you have one.
- Threads: neutrals (white, grey, off white). We'll bring some colors for topstitching.
- Basic sewing kit: scissors, pins, seam ripper, etc.

Turners: bring a bodkin to help smooth out the seams, scissors and seam ripper.

Pressers: bring a mister if you have one. We have several ironing boards and irons.

Bead bags: bring scissors and a bodkin, if you have one. We do have some bodkins.

Also remember to bring a snack or lunch and a drink. Everyone will be treated to ice cream sundaes and cookies. We all scream for ice cream! Yay!
