July 18th Quiltathon

Thanks to all those that signed up for the July charity workshop. We have lots to do, but let's have some fun doing it! There is a Polish Proverb that says "make haste slowly". It means to cut, sew, and press with due diligence to accomplish our task. It's important we do our jobs well because our name goes on every quilt.

Details

Set up, layer, pin, trim

Arrive at **8:30 a.m.** to set up the room.

Bring a pair of sharp long-bladed scissors to trim the quilts. I use those Fiskars spring-loaded ones ... they're easier on my hands. We have everything else!

Sewers

Arrive at **9 a.m.**

Bring your sewing machine with a walking foot and decorative, if possible. Bring a darning foot if you can free motion quilt.

Bring an ext. cord or multiplug.

Bring your basic sewing kit – scissors, seam ripper, neutral thread for sewing around quilts, colored thread for topstitching and quilting.

Turners

Arrive at **9 a.m.**

Bring a bodkin.

Pressers

Arrive at **9 a.m.**

We have 5 ironing boards and 4 irons at the community center.

Bring your own iron, if you like it better.

Bring a bottle of water or mister. It'll help to get those wrinkles out.

Everyone pack your lunch or snack and a drink. For dessert we will be serving ice cream sundaes with all the toppings. Yum!!
